ALL STUDENTS IN FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM

We will celebrate Mass to say thank-you for a year full of Faith, Fun and Learning on WEDNESDAY, 18th December at 9:00am. At the conclusion of Mass the Student Leadership Team for 2014 will be announced. This will then be followed by our Annual Awards Ceremony. There are four special awards for each class that are selected by the class teacher.

'Catholic Living' Award - to recognize the child who the teacher believes continually demonstrates and lives out our catholic values.

'Academic' Award - to recognize the child who the teacher believes has on average achieved exceptional results across the area of Numeracy.

The selection process for these awards involves teachers nominating students they feel best suit the criteria and then voting on these children.

during the October holidays.


Our School community was sent a special message from Sacred Heart Catholic College at Wadeye.

In January Anthony Matthews will be travelling to East Timor to participate in the *East Timor Training Program* for the teachers of East Timor. The joint initiative between the Diocese of Parramatta and Broken Bay has been operating for over ten years. Three times a year, three teachers from Parramatta Diocese and Broken Bay Diocese travel to East Timor to conduct a two-week training program for the teachers of East Timor. This program aims to share our knowledge of good teaching and learning to the teachers in East Timor, so they can ensure the quality of the East Timorese children's education.

In October 2012 Mr Matthews travelled to East Timor as a team member of the East Timor Mathematics-Training Program for teachers of Timor-Leste.

As part of his ongoing sense of mission and involvement with this initiative Anthony Matthews is returning, but this time to facilitate a training program for English Teachers in the township of *Same* in the *Manufahi District*.

This wonderful experience is one, which not only the teachers of East Timor learn from Anthony Matthews' teaching experience, but more importantly an experience where he will continue to learn from the people of Timor. On return he will be able to share his immersion experience and journey towards gaining solidarity from the people of East Timor.

Fundraising

In support of this mission we will be holding a fundraising day for the East Timor Training Program.

On Wednesday **December 11**th will be **Rice Wednesday For Timor**. Anthony Matthews has shared with us that when he was in East Timor that each morning the teachers/ parents would clean and cook rice for the children so they didn't learn on an empty stomach. Anthony Matthews will be conducting a lesson on mission with each grade and following this the students will have an opportunity to have a cup of rice. If you wish for your child to not have the cup of rice please write a letter to your child's classroom teacher.

We ask that in support of this program if your child brings a gold coin donation to support this invaluable mission for the East Timorese community. Your support will be greatly appreciated.

CHILD PROTECTION—CEO PARRAMATTA MODULE & THE NEW WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK



The Working with Children Check is now a three step process which includes Completion of the CEO Online Child Protection Module and Completion of the 'new working with children check' through the NSW Commission for Children website. Applicants will then need to present the completed documentation at their local Roads & Maritime Service (RMS) Office (formally RTA) for screening which completes the check.

1. It is a Diocesan requirement that any parent volunteering at Christ the King School complete the Child Protection training module.

This training is to be completed online at:

http://childprotection.parra.catholic.edu.au

CTK will receive email notification when you complete the CEO module. The Child Protection module MUST be completed every 2 years.

2. When module has been completed go to: www.kids.nsw.gov.au and follow the links to complete the 'new working with children check'. A Working With Children Check is a prerequisite for anyone in child-related work. It involves a national criminal history check and review of findings of workplace misconduct.

Only paid workers in child-related work are required to pay the \$80 fee for a five year clearance. This equates to \$16 per year, the lowest in Australia (together with Victoria).

The Working With Children Check remains free for:

- Volunteers and students
- Authorised carers

- Potential adoptive parents
- Adults who reside in the home of:
 - an authorised carer
 - a family day care service provider
- a home-based education and care service provider.
- 3. Once the RMS check has been completed you will receive an email which will state that you have clearance to work with children. A copy of the RMS email will need to be presented to the school office to complete your Working with Children Check. Only then will you be cleared to work with the children in the school.
